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In order to facilitate students gaining the maximum benefit from supervised study the following will apply:

- 1. Places will be allocated to students on a first come first served basis.
- 2. Students will be given assigned seating.
- 3. The school Code of Behaviour applies to supervised study.
- 4. <u>Study begins at the times outlined above</u>, unless otherwise advised. Students are expected to be punctual for all study periods. If, due to unforeseen circumstances, a student is late a note from a parent/guardian/teacher will be required by the study supervisor.
- 5. Students who arrive late for any study period without a valid reason (note from a parent or a teacher) will receive a note in their journal.
- 6. If a student wishes to leave study early, they must have a written note in their journal, <u>a</u> text message is not acceptable. If a student has no note, then they will not be allowed leave. A parent/guardian may sign a student out of study but they will have to come to the study hall to do this.
- 7. School management will not tolerate students loitering in any other part of the school during supervised study. <u>Students attend study or leave the school building.</u>
- 8. A record of attendance and any other information (e.g. students' punctuality, behaviour, etc.) will be recorded by the teacher on duty.
- 9. Only school sanctioned electronic equipment is allowed in the study hall. <u>Earphones</u> <u>are not permitted.</u>
- 10. Students should go to their lockers and use the toilet before study begins to minimise disruption during study.
- 11. Persistent poor time-keeping or refusal by a student to co-operate with his/her supervisor may lead to suspension or, in more serious cases, expulsion from supervised study. In this situation fees will be forfeited. **Refunds are not available to students who drop out of study**.
- 12. Students with behavioural issues may find that supervised study is unsuitable to their needs. Consider carefully the rules, regulations and your ability to adhere to them before joining supervised study.
- 13. The school reserves the right to refuse students access to supervised study.
