Dear Parents/Guardians & Students,

Uniform, Attendance & Punctuality

Thank you to all those who continue to showcase exemplary **uniform**, **attendance and punctuality**. Summer Exams

Summer exams will commence on <u>Monday 30th of May 2022</u> for 1st year, 2nd year and 5th year. These will be conducted in block classes. The exam timetable will be shared with students this week and will also be available on the school app.

<u>Students in 3rd and 6th year will have block classes beginning on Monday 30th of May 2022</u>, these will afford the students the last opportunity to work with their teachers as they prepare for their JC and LC exams respectively. The timetable for these classes will be shared with students this coming week.

Awards Night

Over the past number of years, we have held our Awards night in late May. This is always a great night in the school calendar as we get to recognise the success and achievements of our wonderful students. Our last inperson Awards night was held in 2019. This year, we have made the decision to revert to an in-person awards ceremony but this will now be held in September 2022. A date and details of same will be confirmed at the start of the new 2022/2023 academic year. This promises to be a great night and we intend to give out more awards than in previous year with a number of new categories added to recognise the great students we have and the wonderful achievements many have both in and outside of the school setting.

We will be briefing all students before they finish regarding the exams, what they should expect and what is expected from them.
